

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Clarke County, Iowa:

Section 1. Supervisor Districts

The following districts are established pursuant to Iowa Code section 331.210 for the election of members of the Board of Supervisors:

Supervisor District 1: All of Madison Township, Troy Township, including the incorporated town of Murray, Doyle Township, Washington Township, Ward Township, Knox Township, Green Bay Township, Franklin Township and Jackson Township, including the incorporated town of Woodburn.

Supervisor District 2: All of Liberty Township, Fremont Township, Osceola Township and Precinct 1 and Precinct 4 in the City of Osceola.

Supervisor District 3: Precinct 2 and Precinct 3 in the City of Osceola.

Section 2. Election Precincts

The following voting Precincts are established for use during elections, subject to the authority of the County Commissioner of Elections to combine voting precincts as permitted by law:

Middle Precinct: All of Washington Township, Ward Township, Knox Township and Green Bay Township.

Murray Precinct: All of Madison Township, Troy Township, including the incorporated town of Murray, and Doyle Township.

North East Precinct: All of Osceola Township, Fremont Township, Liberty Township and Precinct 4 in the city of Osceola.

Osceola Precinct One: As defined by ordinance adopted by the Osceola City Council.

Osceola Precinct Two: As defined by ordinance adopted by the Osceola City Council.

Osceola Precinct Three: As defined by ordinance adopted by the Osceola City Council.

Woodburn Precinct: All of Jackson Township, including the incorporated city of Woodburn and Franklin Township.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 4. Severability Clause

If any section, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
