

Unofficial Special Election Results – September 30, 2008

Local Option Sales Tax Use Change Referendum

The use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax shall be changed in the **following areas**, effective January 1, 2009.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:
0% for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended, is:

To fund, under one or more agreements, the acquisition of land, planning, design, construction, equipping, and maintenance while any project debt is outstanding, for the Clarke County Reservoir Project.

CURRENT USES OF THE TAX:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenues are otherwise expended is:

To design, construct, equip and maintain the Clarke County Water Reservoir and related infrastructure until such time as all debt incurred is fully paid.
