**August 23, 2021** The Clarke County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on August 23, 2021, at the Clarke County Courthouse with the following members present: Dean Robins, Larry Keller and Austin Taylor. Also present, Auditor Janice White, Emergency Management Coordinator/Zoning Byron Jimmerson, and Environmental Health Clerk Jessica Conley. Chairman Dean Robins called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Larry Keller made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Austin Taylor. All Ayes.

**Res 21-117** – Moved by Austin Taylor, seconded by Larry Keller to approve iWorQ Service Agreement for online tracking and compliance for many types of county permits, subdivisions, variances and more.

**Res 21-118** – Moved by Larry Keller, seconded by Austin Taylor to approve application for Delores Robins to build a 75-foot-wide driveway entrance on 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Section 28 of Troy Township.

Discussion was held at 10:00 a.m. regarding the railroad bridge on 110<sup>th</sup> Street in Troy Township. Numerous adjoining landowners and interested public were in attendance. It was explained that the railroad owns the bridge (not the county) and the railroad has closed it. Discussion with the railroad has just begun regarding this bridge.
