APPROVE 2024 CANVASS OF GENERAL ELECTION

The Board of Supervisors and the Clarke County Auditor Janice White met in regular session on Wednesday, November 13, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. and proceeded to canvass the votes cast at the General Election held on November 5, 2024. Supervisors present were Dean Robins and Randy Dunbar. Austin Taylor was absent. After canvassing the returns of each voting precinct in the county, the following candidates were declared elected to the respective listed office. (All four-year terms unless indicated differently.)

There were eight provisional ballots and four were rejected and not counted.

Four thousand five hundred fifty-two (4,552) people voted out of six thousand two hundred forty-seven (6,247) registered voters in Clarke County.
