At 9:00 am, the Board of Supervisors of Clarke County, Iowa, met for a public hearing on Proposed Tax Levy for FY27. Members present: Chairman Randy Dunbar, Brian Sorensen, and Dean Robins.

Motion by Dean Robins, seconded by Brian Sorensen to approve agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

Auditor Jessica Graves provided the levy rates according to the property tax levy posting. A member of the public questioned how the proposed levy rate will impact their taxes individually. Another member had questions regarding the General Supplement levy. Auditor Graves stated the tax levy had decreased slightly, however the amount of tax dollars requested increased. The actual impact on individual taxes will vary depending on property tax classifications. The General Supplement levy decreased slightly and can be used for specific items outlined in code such as emergency management agency, elections, and insurance.
