The Clarke County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 4, 2026 at the Clarke County Courthouse with the following members present: Randy Dunbar, Dean Robins, and Brian Sorensen. Also present, Auditor Jessica Graves, Assistant Engineer Corey Eckels, Osceola Sentinel Editor Candra Brooks and members of the public. Chairman Randy Dunbar called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Brian Sorensen made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Dean Robins. All Ayes.

Res 26-072 – WHEREAS, the Clarke County Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as “the Board”, believes the FM-C020(130)--55-20, hereafter referred to as “the project” is in the best interest of Clarke County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as a bridge replacement project; and

WHEREAS, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa for notifications, hearings, and bidding/letting; and

WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Clarke County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by Board to accept the bid from Vogel Traffic Service, Inc. in the amount of \$75,243.47 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of The Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clarke County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor’s bond and certificate of insurance, Justin L. Savage, the County Engineer for Clarke County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.
