The Clarke County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on May 18, 2026 at the Clarke County Courthouse with the following members present: Randy Dunbar, Dean Robins, and Brian Sorensen. Also present, Auditor Jessica Graves and Clarke County Sanitation Director David Rhodes. Chairman Randy Dunbar called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Brian Sorensen made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Dean Robins. All Ayes.

**Res 26-082** - The Board of Supervisors met on May 18, 2026, for a public hearing on the Proposed wastewater treatment and disposal system ordinance. Members present were Randy Dunbar and Brian Sorensen. Dean Robins was present via phone. Also present, County Auditor Jessica Graves and Clarke County Sanitation Director David Rhodes.
