The Clarke County Board of Supervisors met in special session on May 20, 2026 at the Clarke County Courthouse with the following members present: Randy Dunbar, Dean Robins, and Brian Sorensen. Also present, Auditor Jessica Graves and Osceola Sentinel Editor Candra Brooks. Chairman Randy Dunbar called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Brian Sorensen made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Dean Robins. All Ayes.
